

Services



General and civil construction

With over 35 years of residential and commercial construction experience, SWF has completed projects ranging in size from minor renovations to highend harbourside residences. We specialise in quality, and high-end craftsmanship, providing clients with the expertise, knowledge, and technology needed to ensure our projects exceed expectations.

Our services range from temporary and protection work to complete construction. Our ability to offer temporary works and site accommodation enables us to manage our operations securely, particularly when they are conducted in active domestic and civil contexts.

Waterfront construction and maintenance

SWF combines resources with Dick Rowe Marine for marina installation and maintenance to ensure project effectiveness and efficiency. From building to beautifying, SWF can provide the resources to maintain a commercial wharf, through our access to barge hire, marine pile driving, bridge maintenance, wharf construction, diving services and sea walls. We also have access to two 1000m² plus yards in the ports of Kurnell, NSW and Airlie Beach, Qld. Available equipment includes:

- Aluminium barges
- Piling barges
- 6m Fibreglass tender vessel
- 52-foot accommodation vessel
- Six tabletop trucks

Salvage

Our combined teams have literally 'grown up' on the water. They bring extensive experience in water construction, salvage and mechanicals, understanding the logistics required to undertake salvage works for both private and public entities. This can range from abandoned or submerged vessels and assets to relocation of structures and debris.

SWF provides waterfront construction, clean up, rubbish removal and labour hire. We make waterfront projects accessible and cost-effective by using our own supplies, including a wet and dry barge, excavator, and crane truck/tipper. We can also supply bulker bags and a high-pressure cleaner.

Due the available marine assets and experienced staff, we can undertake salvage works on behalf of government agencies and private entities.

Our recent work portfolio includes:

- A major salvage operation, recovering and searching an abandoned drug ship for evidence of narcotics (in conjunction with Birdon in 2018)
- Salvage of thirty Privately owned Vessels in Port Hacking and Botany Bay (salvaged intact for repairs) 2021
- Scrapping of three barges on Botany Bay in 2022.







Vessel maintenance

We can supply genuine OEM parts, undertake routine maintenance tasks and identify, diagnose, and repair unexpected faults as they arise. The 1500m² workshop and yard at Taren Point is ideally located, enabling the fleet of nine mobile service vehicles to easily supply the metropolitan area and beyond.

SWF also enjoys strong partner relationships with external crane companies. On short notice, we have the connections to lift engines and large transmissions out of vessels, whether dealing with challenging sites, tides or weather conditions.

Together, we have the capacity to maintain a range of commercial vessels including Fast Ferry vessels, Defence vessels, NSW Maritime, and NSW Volunteer Coast Guard vessels.
